Roadway is a certified participant of the **Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism (C-TPAT)**.

To better support homeland security efforts and aid in the prevention of illegal cross border activity, **C-TPAT** customers and carriers have submitted to a voluntary certification process with Cross Border Protection and the United States government to ensure that all cross border practices meets the highest level of quality and integrity.

If your company has obtained **C-TPAT** certification then you know the benefits of using Roadway for your cross border shipping needs.

When circumstances would require an elevation in the national threat level, U.S. Customs will increase examinations of cargo and conveyances. While elevated alert levels would have no adverse impact on C-TPAT/FAST processing, other cargo would be subject to a greater degree of inspection.

In the event of a security-related U.S. border closure, the majority of cross border trade would stop completely. **Only C-TPAT certified customers shipping with C-TPAT certified carriers will be able to continue cross border traffic if the U.S. borders have been closed.**

**If you are C-TPAT certified, please inform your local Roadway sales representative of your C-TPAT SVI certification number. Once we verify your SVI number in the Cross Border Protection's data base, we will be able to enter your company in Roadway's system as a C-TPAT certified customer and you will begin to receive the benefits of your cross border certification.**
